The City of Lighthouse Point is seeking qualified and committed persons for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic.

Job Description

The position requires an individual to perform general duty firefighting work in combating, extinguishing, and preventing fires and operating firefighting apparatus. An employee in this class is responsible for the protection of life and property through firefighting activities; rescue operations; fire prevention inspections; and administration of emergency medical services. The employee performs under the supervision of the shift Captain. Overall medical supervision and medical direction is under the City's Medical Director.

Minimum Job Qualifications

High school diploma or GED. Previous experience as a firefighter or paramedic a plus.

Special Requirements

Must be a Florida certified firefighter. Must possess a valid State of Florida Paramedic certification. Must possess and maintain a valid Class "E" driver's license for the State of Florida. Must possess an Emergency Vehicle Operator Course (EVOC) certificate. Must possess a valid ACLS certification and BLS CPR Healthcare Provider certification. Must be an active member of the Broward County MESH program or possess a current CPAT card or BC-FRAT list.
