
1. Canvass votes and declare the results of the March 14, 2017 Municipal Election.

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**SUBJECT:** Declare the results of the March 14, 2017 Municipal Election.

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**1. BACKGROUND/HISTORY**

Pursuant to City Charter, Article VII. Elections:  
Section 5. Results of the Voting.

The results of the voting, when ascertained, shall be certified by return in duplicate, signed by the city clerk and the majority of the inspectors of the election, one copy delivered to the mayor, and the other to the city clerk, both of whom shall transmit such returns to the city commission at a called meeting to be held not later than five (5) days after such election.

At such meeting, the city commission shall canvass the returns, and in absence of a declaration of contest by any of the candidates in such election, shall declare the results of the election as shown by the returns made by the city clerk and inspectors. The city clerk shall within two (2) days thereafter furnish each person shown to have been elected a certificate thereof. A tie between two (2) or more candidates shall be determined as prescribed by ordinance. The candidates receiving the highest number of votes shall be determined to have been elected.
