RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 1838

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LIGHTHOUSE POINT, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING LOBBYIST REGISTRATION FEES; AMENDING "APPENDIX A – FEE SCHEDULE" TO THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE FOR SUCH FEES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission has adopted Ordinance No. 2011-0897, which established regulations for lobbying activities in the City and authorized the establishment of fees for lobbyist registration activities; and,

WHEREAS, City Administration recommends that a fee of \$100.00 be set for each lobbyist registration, and update thereto, filed with the City Clerk; and,

WHEREAS, the City Commission agrees with the recommendation of City Administration, and finds that it is in the best interest of the City to establish the lobbyist registration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LIGHTHOUSE POINT, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. The City Commission hereby establishes Lobbyist Registration and Update Fees, authorized by Ordinance 2011-0897, as follows:

APPENDIX A – FEE SCHEDULE

ADMINISTRATION

City clerk's office fees and charges. The city clerk's office shall charge the following prices:

. . . .

(4) Lobbyist Statement Registration Fees:

- (a) Lobbyist Statement Filing \$100.00.
- (b) Lobbyist Statement Update* \$100.00.

*Each update shall be charged a separate fee.

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Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.



Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.



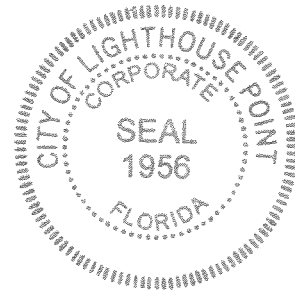
