We understand how much you depend on electricity every day and are committed to making improvements to keep your lights on. That's why we are working on a project in your area that will help improve your service reliability.

This project will strengthen the main power line serving your area. Work is scheduled to begin June 2015 and is expected to be completed by May 2016. We will be working along Hillsboro Mile from 1149 to 1039; NE 39 Street from NE 31 Avenue to NE 23 Avenue and NE 41 Street; NE 30 Avenue from NE 39 Street to NE 42 Street and NE 41 Street, NE 39 Street, E Sample Road and NE 15 Terrace. We'll do everything possible to keep any power interruptions to a minimum while this work is in progress. Should a longer outage become necessary to complete the work, we'll notify you in advance.

While we deliver better than 99.98 percent service reliability, we're never satisfied. As part of our storm-strengthening efforts, we plan to invest approximately half a billion dollars over the next three years to make improvements across our service area. Although severe weather will continue to cause some outages, we're committed to making improvements, such as these, to help keep your lights on or get them back on faster while offering bills that are among the lowest of all 55 electric utilities in Florida.
