


Dredged Material Management Areas in Broward County

FIND owns three upland Dredged Material Management Areas (DMMA's) within Broward's 25 miles of Intracoastal Waterway as part of its permanent, long-range dredged material management plan. MSA-726 was purchase as three (3) separate parcels in 1936, 1942 and 1954. FIND has leases this property previously to Hillsboro Improvement and Maintenance District for its use during inlet dredging operations. FIND has a current lease agreement (through August 2016) with the City of Pompano Beach in cooperation with the City of Lighthouse Point for recreational purposes.

FIND will be working this the US Army Corps of Engineers to dredge existing shoals within Broward Reach 1 of the Intercoastal Waterway. This project is expected to take place at some point in 2017. Beach compatible sand will be placed oceanside and the remaining material may be processed and handled at FIND's MSA-726. MSA-726 may also be used to stage equipment as necessary for the dredging project.
