

Separating Your Debris

Debris should be placed curbside, without blocking the roadway or storm drains.

PLEASE DO NOT PLACE DEBRIS IN TRASH BAGS.

NO PICKUP ZONE

Any debris placed from the sidewalk toward your property will not be picked up.

STORM DEBRIS SEPARATION

Separate debris into the five categories shown below.

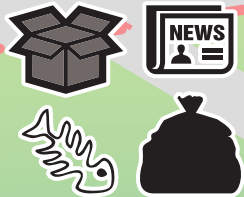
DO NOT STACK OR LEAN

Placing debris near or on trees, poles, fire hydrants or meters makes removal difficult. Be sure to keep debris away from storm drains. Avoid placing piles on driveways or private paved surfaces.

UNSURE WHERE TO PLACE DEBRIS?

If you don't have a sidewalk, ditch, or utility line in front of your house, place debris at the edge of your property before the curb.

No Bulk Pickup until further notice



Normal Household Trash and Recycling

Place household trash in garbage/recycling bins as usual, place separate from storm debris, normal pick up days



VEGETATIVE DEBRIS

Leaves- if already in bags, place with normal trash
Logs
Plants
Tree branches
Palm fronds
