TRAFFIC AND PARKING CHANGES

44TH, 45TH, 46TH, & 47TH STREETS

Dear Residents,

As many of you know, we continue to see a dramatic increase in vehicle and pedestrian traffic on our streets Halloween evening. Without some form of police intervention concerning traffic & parking controls, we have found it near impossible to get emergency vehicles down some of these streets during Halloween.

This year, on Halloween evening, Tuesday, October 31st, from 6:00 pm to 11:00 pm, we will once again be restricting the amount of vehicular traffic allowed on your streets. With the exception of residents and their limited guests for the evening, no vehicles will be permitted to enter this area from 22nd Avenue after 6:00 pm. Additionally, any vehicles parked on these streets MUST be parked on the south side ONLY!

We know that by limiting vehicular traffic during the noted time will make for a safer event for the children who walk these streets trick-or-treating. Additionally, in the event of an emergency, police and fire response vehicles can travel down the street.
